

Rules for 2011 Women's 18 Hole League

1. Tee times will start at 3:30 and go until 4:15; everyone will start on #1 or #10 depending on what side you will start on.
2. Your schedule will tell you who your opponent as all individual matches will pair Division #1 vs. Division #1 and Division #2 vs. Division #2. I will decide randomly who your partner will be for that night, it will change each week and will be someone from the other Division.
3. Scorecards will be given out at the beginning of each day; handicaps, strokes given and the starting hole for that night.
4. There are 21 points at stake for 18 holes of league play:
1 Point per hole = 18 points for 18 holes
1 Points for low net Team score on Front
1 Point for low net Team score on Back
1 Points for Low net Team score Total
= 21 Total player points.
5. After the match, a player from the group is responsible to return the scorecard **IMMEDIATELY** back to the golf shop. It should be properly filled out with the correct score and points awarded for each player.
6. Forfeiture of points or match: if and only if a player does not show, they forfeit 18 points to their opponent. If they arrive late, meaning their team has teed off their particular starting hole. The player will then forfeit that hole and take a penalty of 1 net stroke higher than her opponent.
7. If a player gets a sub, please let the golf shop know by at least 1:00 that Tuesday, so proper changes can be made. Players are responsible for finding their own subs. At last resort may you call the golf shop to help assist you in finding a sub.
8. Jeff will post scores into GHIN; you will be able to find the standings posted on the league board or on the website, www.indiantrailsclub.com, under the News section of the website by Thursday.

Ladies Rules for 2011 Women's 9 Hole League

1. Jeff will post all starting holes on the front counter and window of the golf shop. He will give out score cards before play starts and assign starting holes for all competitors.
2. The difference between the individual's handicaps is the number of strokes given to that individual for the match. Example Player 1 is a 22 handicap and her opponent (Player 2) is a 30 handicap. Player 2 would then receive 8 strokes for 9 holes starting with the hardest handicapped hole.
3. A total of 24 points will be awarded for each match
 - a. One point will be awarded per hole for the individual with the lowest net total at the end of the hole. In a 9 hole match there will be 9 points, in the case of a tie on any hole each team will receive $\frac{1}{2}$ a point.
 - b. Three points will be awarded to the individual that has the lowest net team score for the entire 9 holes of play. (Individuals Total Score - handicap received) = Individual net score.
4. When the round is completed, each team will tabulate their score and how many points were earned. Then PLEASE return it to the golf shop and Jeff will post your score along with the points for your particular team.
5. Forfeiture of points or match: if and only if a player does not show, they forfeit 9 points to their opponent. If they arrive late, meaning their team has teed off their particular starting hole. The team will then forfeit that hole and take a penalty of 1 net stroke higher than her opponent.
6. If a player gets a sub, please let the golf shop know by at least 1:00 that Tuesday, so proper changes can be made. Players are responsible for finding their own subs. At last resort may you call the golf shop to help assist you in finding a sub.
